Pre registration is encouraged at <http://bikereg.com>. The entry fee increases to \$30 on May 1st. Day-of race entry fee is \$40.

Registration: opens at 7:00 am and closes 15 min prior to posted start times.

Course: The Smoketown Airport Criterium course offer the unique experience of racing on an airport runway. This course offers the spectators a full view of the race from just about anywhere along the course. The course is a 1 mile loop with 3 gradual turns and one 180 degree high speed corner. The course starts on the 2500ft long 25ft wide slightly uphill taxi-way. The first turn is a sweeping 90 degree left turn that takes you across the runway toward the fueling station. The next turn is another sweeping 90 degree left turn that takes you to the fueling station. After a short straight stretch there is a small left to right "S" turn that takes you to the main runway. The run way is 50ft wide and heads slightly downhill toward a fast 180 degree turn. The lap finishes about 200 yards up the taxi-way stretch.
